As you are no doubt aware, the government and teacher unions are currently in negotiation. At this stage teachers are unhappy with the offer that has been made to them and feel compelled to voice their concerns through strike action. The first part of this action coincides with our planned **Teacher Only Day (Friday 31 May)** and the public holiday, **Queen's Birthday (Monday 4 June)**. This means that over the next two weeks there will be disruption to the normal school operation.

Please read the information below carefully so that you can make suitable arrangements for your child over this time.

Wednesday 29 May -National Strike action.

- Teachers are **NOT** available for work
- Students are **NOT** required to be at school on this day

NB: Buses will **NOT** be operating on this day

Friday 31 May: TEACHER ONLY DAY

- Teachers are participating in Professional Development
- Students are **NOT** required on this day

Rostering Home is also industrial action being taken by teachers. Teachers are withdrawing teaching this year level on the following days. At this stage we have the following information. All other students Yr 10-13 should attend. Buses will run as normal.
